HOW TO PARTICIPATE

1. Choose the desired activities with your son/daughter.

Sign up for as many activities as you wish. Classes are on a first-come, first-serve basis and may be cancelled due to low enrollment. Circle your choices on the course schedule (on back) and keep for your records. Return the bottom portion of the registration form to the Main Office.

2. Complete both sides of the registration form below.

A separate registration form is required for each student. Incomplete forms will delay registration.

3. Return the registration form along with payment (check, cash, money order) to the main office of your school.

COST

The fees for TWIST are as follows:

'ALL ACCESS' ANNUAL PASS - one time fee of \$75 for the year. Entitles student to an unlimited number of clubs and activities per week for the school year. Open Café requires an All Access Pass. If purchased after the first session, the fee will be prorated. Details on back of form.

'A LA CARTE' PASS- \$10 per session. 1 day per week attendance= \$10 per session.

THE FINE PRINT

The staff at TWIST want your son's/daughter's after-school experience to be a positive one. Our goal is to provide a fun and safe learning environment for all participants. Please review the following information with your son or daughter.

BEHAVIOR STANDARDS - Students participating in the program are held to the Laconia School District's Behavior Standards. **Repeated disruptions or disrespect for others and/or for their property may result in removal from the program.**

DISMISSAL - Students attending TWIST clubs will stay in their team classrooms until clubs begin at 2:51. At the end of TWIST activities, students will be dismissed as indicated on your registration form. Any student signing out early must have a note to do so, or guardians will be called.

ABSENCE FROM PROGRAM - Please notify the LMS office *in advance* if your child will not be attending a scheduled club or activity. Time does not allow for parents to be contacted when students are absent from the afterschool programs. Fees will not be refunded. Parents will be contacted in the case that the student has a pattern of absence from the club(s) they registered for.

CANCELLATION - The program does not operate on holidays, school vacation periods or early release days and will be cancelled when schools close due to inclement weather or unforeseen events. Notification will be made through the school's standard procedure. In these cases, courses will not be rescheduled and fees will not be refunded.
