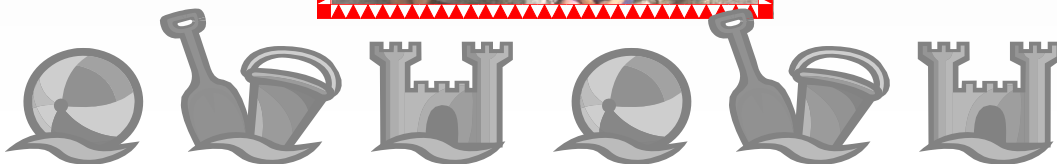

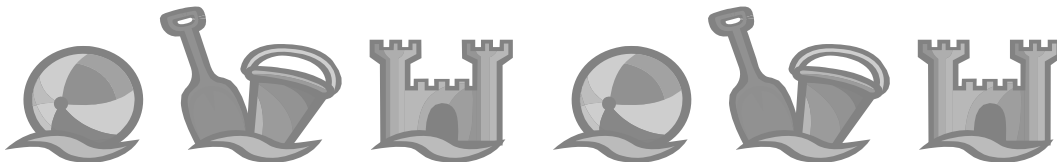

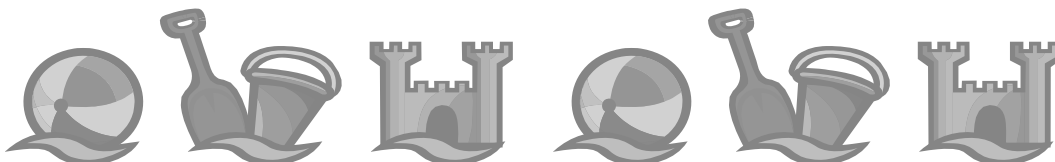
## **ACTIVITIES**
